## Letter of Agreement Requirement to Create Additional Fibre Op Project Term Workforce

- 1. The Company and the Council agree that there will likely be a need to create an additional Project Term Workforce to respond to the increased demand for FibreOp in Atlantic Canada with respect to expansion of the footprint and/or increased penetration of the FibreOp service in existing markets.
- 2. The Company and the Council agree that the timeframe associated with the creation of any such Project Term Workforce is uncertain at this time.
- 3. When the need arises to create a Project Term Workforce, the parties agree that 20% of the positions required will be made available first to existing employees and the remaining 80% will be staffed by external hires. Any roles that are made available to existing employees, but not filled by existing employees, will be made available to external hires.
- 4. The parties will meet and discuss the following elements of the Project Term Workforce:
  - Locations of employees
  - Numbers of employees
