Eligible for consideration are **NBFL affiliates, as well as provincial and community organizations**, undertaking or sponsoring, partially or fully, literacy projects and workplace related training activities including union developed programs.

Selection criteria include project worthiness, and potential benefits to workers, unions and the community.

Applications must be on the prescribed form and must be received by the secretary of the New Brunswick Federation of Labour Education Committee not later than **June 30th** of each year.

The successful applicant will be notified by the New Brunswick Federation of Labour Education Committee and official announcement of the winner will be made by the Secretary-Treasurer of the New Brunswick Federation of Labour.
